Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Assembly—Friday, 13th June—9:00am. This assembly was run by the Kindy / Pre-Primary students with assistance from our Student Councillors. Class visits took place following the assembly—a 15 minute opportunity to chat with your child and see some of the work they have been doing. I hope you are enjoying these visits.

**Police Pipe Band—Friday, 13th June—**we were very privileged to have the Police Pipe Band visit us and put on a performance for all to enjoy. This took place at 10:15am with all students attending this performance. I'm sure the kids enjoyed listening to the bagpipes and learning how they work.

**Reports:** Teachers are busy finalizing 1st Semester reports which will be ready to post on Connect on Friday, 27th June. There will then be the opportunity to make an appointment to meet with the teacher to discuss any concerns you may have, or just to clarify how your child is going in the class.

A Roster will be placed on the Library wall for you to put your name against a time slot. I look forward to seeing a lot of parents take this opportunity to have a chat with the teacher and work together for the benefit of your child. Remember with our reporting system that a "C" level means that they are performing at their grade level and progressing well.

**End-of-Term Assembly:** Our final assembly for 2nd term will be held on Friday, 27th June—9:00am start. This will be run by our Student Councillors and special Certificates will be presented to acknowledge the academic work done so far this year. All parents are welcome to attend.

**Dance Program:** This will start in Term 3—every Thursday for the 10 weeks, culminating in our Dance Spectacular Performance on Thursday, 25th September from 6:00pm-7:00pm. An Incursion form will be sent home at the end of this term. As it is a whole school program, linked to the Dance Curriculum, all students (K-Yr 6) are expected to participate.
