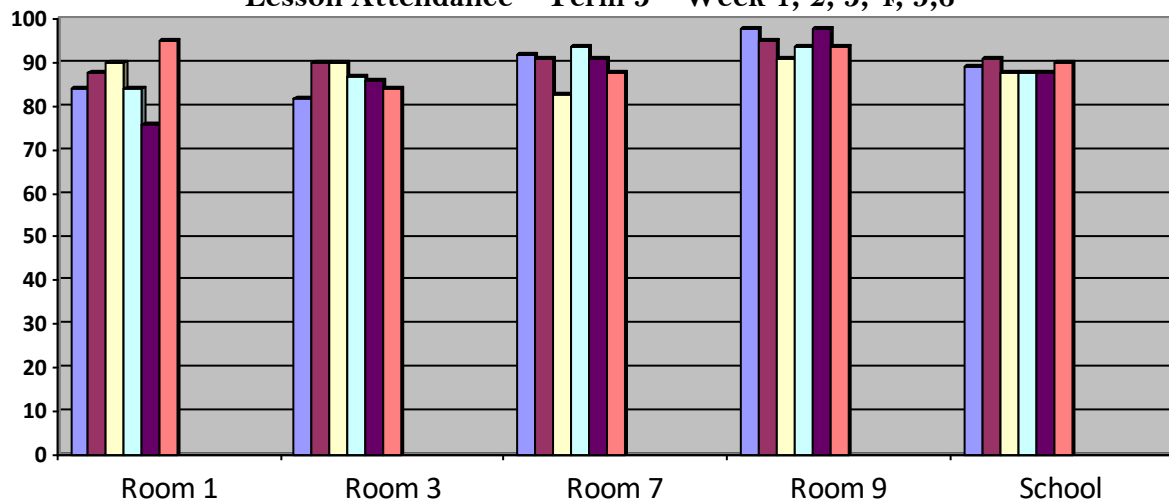

A reminder that short sleeve polos will be available at the start of Term 4 in time for summer.

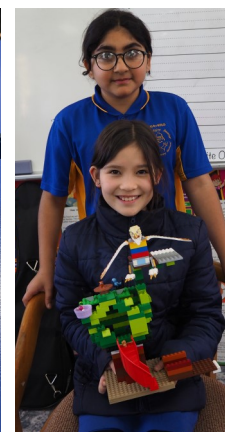
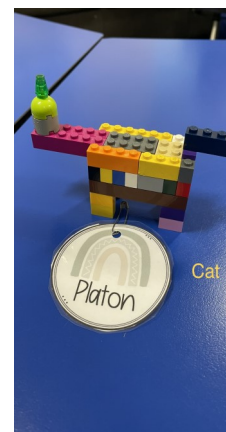
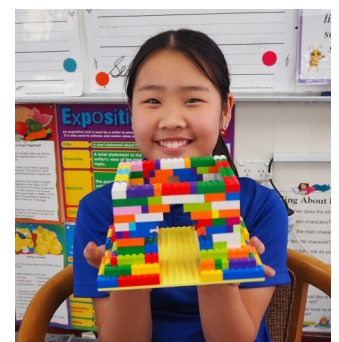
