Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Attendance: Just a reminder to remember to send an explanation note when your child has been absent - even for one day. This can be done electronically, or with a note to the class teacher. Absent notes will be sent home every 3 weeks for unexplained absences. If you receive one these letters, please fill in the reason for absences and return this form to the class teacher. Your child's absence will then be amended to "Explained" and not "Unexplained".

Our solo medallist on the day was: **Aiva** who came a creditable 4th in the Individual Placings of the Year 4 Girls race. Congratulations Aiva!!



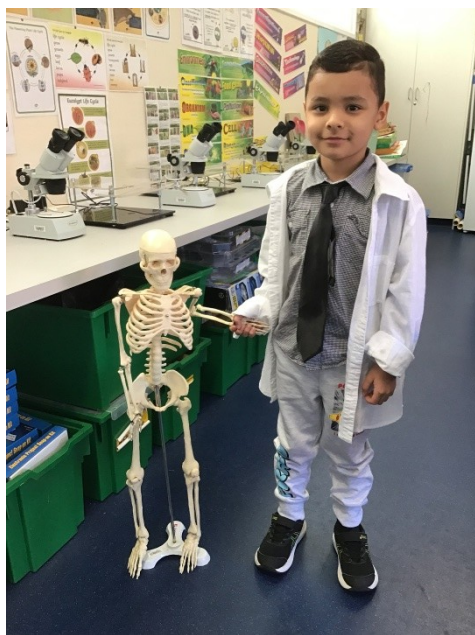
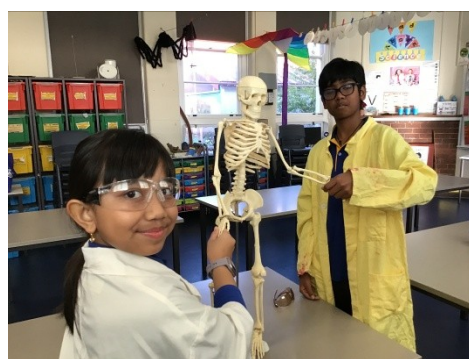

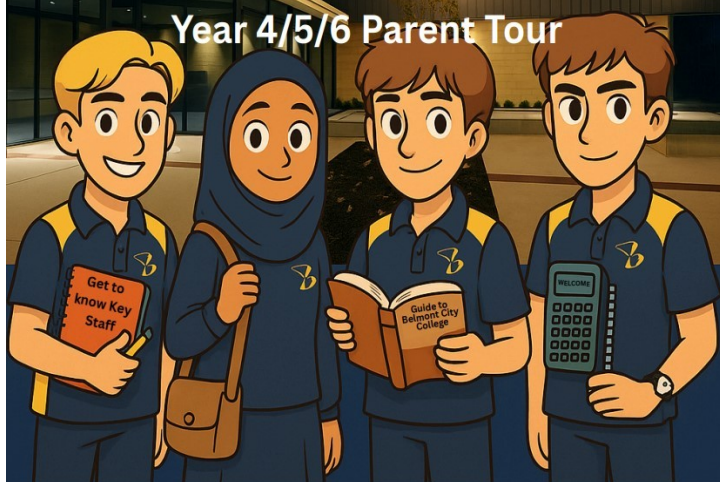
