Dear Parents/Caregivers,

They say that time goes by faster as you get older—and hasn't this term flown by! Only three weeks to go, and we still have lots of events to get through.

Harmony Event: This is celebrated next Friday, 20th March. Students can come to school in their National Costume, and teachers will be doing different activities within their classes during the day. Our **Community Event** will be held that night, starting at 5:30pm and going till 7:00pm. If you can bring a “dish” from your culture to share, that would be fantastic. It will just be a tasting of the different dishes—I will supply the plates and eating utensils. This will be set up in the Undercover area. It would also be “awesome” if you have some dances, songs or activities that you would like to share with everyone. It's an opportunity to get to know parents from our school and to share your experiences. I hope to see you here!

Swimming Lessons: Thanks to all parents who have returned the swimming forms and paid for the lessons—my aim is to have all children from Pre-Primary to Year 6 attend these lessons. Please arrange with the office if you would like to spread the payments with a payment plan.

Children will come home with two notes about the lessons. One is for your information—times, what they are to bring for swimming and school arrangements re: lunch time and bus times. As children will be going home within 1/2 hour from returning from swimming, they will not be getting changed back into their uniforms at school unless they have a medical condition and a note is then required.

The second note is for the Swimming teachers which must be returned to school on Friday, 20th and given to the class teacher. These will then be handed to their swimming teacher on the first day of swimming. If you do not know what swimming level your child is at, please tick the “unsure, please grade” box, and they will be graded at the pool.

Please make sure that all swimming items are **named**—even goggles if they bring them.

NAPLAN: Thanks to Mrs Cleland for organising and supervising the Year 3 & 5 NAPLAN tests. We had none of the disruptions which were noted on the news. I'm sure that all the students did their best. Results should be available in 2nd Term and these will be sent home to the Year 3 & 5 students. Teachers will also analyse the results and look at areas that we will need to add to our planning to ensure that we are covering the areas that need extra support—but, we will also be celebrating the areas that we have succeeded in.

Final Assembly: This will be held on Thursday, 2nd April and will be run by our Student Councillors. This assembly also acknowledges two students in each class who have displayed great citizenship qualities and follow our school values and rules. All parents are welcome to attend this assembly and visit classes for 15 minutes following the assembly.

School Council Meeting: Our first meeting for 2026 will be held next Thursday, 19th March in our Library and starting at 1:30pm. It will be great to see lots of parents there. Remember, this is an opportunity to be part of our planning and policy monitoring—and to also provide parent feedback on different programs, etc at the school.
