*Dear Parents/Caregivers,*

Our first three weeks have just flown by and ended with our first assembly today, run ably by our Year 5/6 class. Congratulations Mrs Obeida and students. The message was a great one—“Bullying—No Way!” Thank you to all students for their wonderful listening skills and audience manners—so impressive. Thanks, too, to all the parents and carers who attended our first assembly. Our next assembly will be run by Room 4 on the 13th March. After the next assembly, parents will be able to visit classes to have a look at the work already done this year—a great opportunity for your children to share their work with you.

**Parent Information Sessions:** Thanks to all parents and carers who attended the class information sessions held after school over this week. There was a great attendance in each class and I trust that you all have a clear picture of what will be happening in your child’s class this year. Don’t forget to check the teacher’s timetable to see when they are available if you would like to organise a one-on-one chat with them. Your child’s diary is a great form of communication and these are checked on a regular basis by the teacher. The School and Class Connect notices also help maintain that line of communication—remember that you can add a comment in the comment section below the notice if you would like to add something for the teacher, or if you would like further clarification on an item that was covered.

**Swimming Information and Permission Notes:** Living in Australia, swimming lessons are essential to ensure that we are safe in the water and to learn survival techniques around water. Our swimming lessons will be held in the last two weeks of school and it is the expectation that all children from Pre-Primary to Year 6 attend these lessons. Permission notes are due back by the 19th March, and payment is due back by the 20th March—but please remember that you can organise a payment plan if needed.

**Harmony Day:** This will be held as a school event with the students (dress in National Costume, etc) on Friday, 20th March, and activities organised within classes by the teachers during the day. I would then like to have a **School Community Harmony Event** that evening so that all family members can attend—like a “getting to know you” event. I would propose that it runs from 5:30-7:00pm, with parents contributing by supplying food from their country and setting up little stalls so that everyone can sample food from around the world. It would also be an awesome opportunity for parents to share some of the different activities that they do in their national country—dances, songs, paintings or games. What do you think? Please add any suggestions via Connect or send me an email on suggestions on how we can make this a wonderful sharing event.

**Coming Events:** Please keep a check of coming events which are listed on the Term Planner and down the side of the newsletter so that you don’t miss out on anything planned. Remember that our first **School Council** meeting will be held on Thursday, 19th March—starting at 1:45pm and going to 3:00pm. We will be looking at the Roles of the School Council, but also giving you the opportunity to note any areas of “school life” you would like to discuss over the next meetings, or even as a special Parent Information Session, separate to School Council. I look forward to see lots of new faces.


